Confidential information shall not include information previously known to me, the general public, or previously recognized as standard practice in the field, and does not include materials otherwise licensed for use by other recognized, certified Goju-kai instructors authorized by the International Karate-do Goju-kai Association, system Supreme Grandmaster, Saiko-Shihan Goshi Yamaguchi.

Each of the parties irrevocably and unconditionally consents to the personal jurisdiction of such courts, consents to service of process in accordance with the procedural rules of such courts, and waives and covenants not to assert any objection to the laying of venue in any such court in any such action. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be void, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and shall be construed in such a manner as to achieve their original purposes in full compliance with the applicable laws and regulations.
